In addition, Leticia has recorded stories for CD, told on radio, appeared in television and film, and has performed in theater. In 1999 she published her first book, "Fold 'n' Tell." She's also a contributing author in two other books.

Leticia has a masters in Communication and Storytelling Studies from East Tennessee State University. She graduated from Brigham Young University cum laude with a Bachelor of Music. In addition, she has a certificate of vocology from the National Center for Voice and Speech/University of Utah.
